### **Host a Toy Drive**

### Let's Get Started!

Step 1: Determine date(s), time(s), and a location for your Toy Drive Drives can be as short as one day or as long as one month. Plan for plenty of time to collect and drop-off your donations.

### Step 2: Set your goal

Determine what items you plan to collect and set a goal. Are you collecting 100 educational toys for teens? 50 books for ages 5 –15? Use our Wish List to collect different items for different age groups.

Step 3: Send us a quick email letting us know about your toy drive If it is open to the public, we will share it on our social media channels! Email Courtney Galvan at courtneygalvan@p2pHelps.org with 'Community Toy Drive' in the subject line.

### Step 4: Promote your Toy Drive.

### Step 5: Drop-off your collection.
