MEETING STAMFORD RESIDENTS WHERE THEY LIVE

As many as 40% of Stamford residents – 21,000 people – struggle to afford basic essentials such as food and housing.

Stamford is now the state's second largest city, in the top ten most expensive places to live in the US, and with the second largest wealth gap in the country. Food insecurity is on the rise, almost doubling since 2021 from 10% to 17%.

For many, wage increases have not kept pace with the high cost of living in Fairfield County. A minimum wage worker must work the equivalent of two full time jobs just to afford Stamford rents. Long-time Stamford residents are facing ever-larger hurdles to remaining here, in their hometown, where they live, work and are raising their families.

Today, P2P is meeting a dramatic rise in demand for food assistance by doubling the amount of nutritious food we are providing to Stamford residents. And the need is only growing.

- Free, nutritious groceries to prepare **2.5M healthy meals annually**
 - Two self-select food pantries designed to resemble small grocery stores serving 2,250 families each month
 - P2P on Wheels, our mobile food pantry that visits seven Stamford neighborhoods each week
 - Door2Door home delivery to homebound residents
- Our newly launched Financial Opportunity Center[®], building economic security through financial supports, one-on-one financial coaching, and access to workforce training opportunities
- Housing solutions that include rent, utilities, and security deposits
- Wrap-around support from a team of bilingual caseworkers, including information and referrals, clothing, diapers, toys, and summer camperships for working families

The challenges facing low-income Stamford residents are great, but not insurmountable. For over 50 years, Person to Person has been the leading non-profit provider of food and wrap-around services to help Stamford residents build economic security. We offer the only full time food pantries serving Stamford.

Our innovative mobile food pantry, *P2P on Wheels*, brings fresh, healthy food directly to our clients, where they live and work. Complete with refrigeration and freezers, the mobile pantry overcomes the barrier of transportation and offers a nimble response to the community's need for assistance. The mobile pantry is equipped with a private, Wi-Fi-enabled office space and is staffed with a trained caseworker to offer culturally-competent, bilingual support with wrap-around resources beyond access to food.

Demand for food assistance has doubled since 2019, and continues to rise. In response, P2P seeks to add a second mobile food pantry, thus immediately doubling our food distribution taking place in Stamford neighborhoods, from 900 families per month to 1,800 families. The second mobile food pantry will allow P2P to offer **three full-time**, **nutritious food programs to Stamford residents**, all with multilingual wrap-around services, offering a comprehensive and efficient solution to the growing demand for food assistance in Stamford. By leveraging our current warehouse, infrastructure, and human resources, we can double our mobile pantry capacity with low incremental marginal cost.
